



Behavior Policies - 2012 Kansas Lions Band at Friends University

NOTE – The following guidelines have been “standard” for the past ten years, our Kansas Lions Band students must abide by these policies. If you cannot abide by these guidelines, **DO NOT** expect that you will be allowed to participate. Final decisions of rule/guideline violations and consequences will be administered by Band Committee Chair (Lion Shari Neidhardt) and Dr. Taylor. The camp is meant to be a fun and learning experience, but as guests of the University you will be expected to act accordingly.

1. No alcohol, tobacco, non-prescription medications, or other drugs.
2. No weapons (includes pocket knives, martial art, etc.) or fireworks (of any sizes/shape/type).
3. Offensive language, intolerant behavior (physical or verbal confrontations), and disrespect of staff will NOT be tolerated.
4. Student band members will not be allowed on the opposite sex floors.
5. Students will not leave the dorm area other than for scheduled practices, events, and meals unless escorted by an adult staff member. You will not leave the campus unless escorted by an adult staff member or prior coordination/approval by Band Committee Chairs (Shari and/or Hans).
6. Students will follow dorm floor policies and stay in their assigned rooms after lights out.
7. Students will adhere to special Friends University and/or Newman University policies as directed.
8. If students drive themselves to band camp, they will be required to turn in their keys to the staff.
9. Wear appropriate clothing. Shirts may not be sleeveless, must cover the stomach and may not have questionable pictures/words. Shorts/pants/skirts may not be worn low, and shorts/skirts must be within 3” of the knee. If you have a question whether clothing item is appropriate, do not bring it. If clothing is deemed inappropriate by the staff, the student will be required to change.
10. Students will pay for lost room keys prior to their departure. Replacement fee is \$25.00.

Students in violation of these Behavior Policies:

- * Will be immediately removed from the State Band program.
- * Parents/guardians will be notified and expected to take the student home immediately.
- * Staff members will enforce these policies with “Zero Tolerance”.

Items to Bring to Camp

- ✍ Individual instruments and music stands (as required)
- ✍ Towels, wash cloths, sheets (twin), pillow case, blanket, pillow or sleeping bag
- ✍ Shower shoes, bath soap, shampoo, hair dryer, personal hygiene items
- ✍ Tennis shoes
- ✍ Appropriate clothing (no offensive or revealing attire allowed) and clothes hangars
- ✍ Medications (all prescription and over-the-counter must be listed on Medical Information sheet)
- ✍ Spending cash (keep to minimum amounts) for sodas, snacks, souvenirs (etc.)
